Dear Trail User:

The Fairmount Park's Trail User Permit Program continues to be successful. An application for the 2010 Fairmount Park Trail User Permit is contained on the reverse of this letter.

The use of the trails is a privilege, which comes with responsibility. Trail users are expected to follow the rules and regulations and to be courteous to other park users and sensitive to the environment. All equestrians and bicyclists over the age of 16, are required to display a valid Fairmount Park Trail User Tag to use the upper trails of the Wissahickon Valley Park and the soft trails of Pennypack Park.

The cost for permit registration is \$20.00 for non-residents of the City of Philadelphia. There is **no charge** for Philadelphia residents; however as in the past, we are asking for your help in maintaining and improving the trails through a tax-deductible contribution to Fairmount Park. A minimum donation of \$20.00 is requested, but all donations will be accepted. Donations will be used for the continued maintenance of the trails and to support the trail management program.

Users who do not possess a valid trail permit or to be in noncompliance of the trail rules and regulations may be subject to a \$25.00 fine.

Last fall with the help of your donations, we were able to install "Help Locator" signs along Forbidden Drive in Wissahickon Valley Park. This effort will be expanded to Pennypack Park this spring. With your continued support, we would like to keep expanding the program throughout other parks and more remote trails.

Also last year we had a successful unveiling of our online permit registration. Online registrants were able to print their permit registration immediately. You can apply online or download an application at www.fairmountpark.org/trailsintro.asp. We encourage you to register online, it is simple, safe and you have the ability to request additional information that may interest you.

Your participation and cooperation are greatly appreciated. Fairmount Park and Staff hope you enjoy your park experience.

Your current **2009 permit** is valid through **March 31, 2010**. To request additional information call 215-683-0220.
