Philadelphia Parks & Recreation will have four two-week sessions beginning on Monday, June 27, 2011. During each session, young Philadelphians will be taught the basics of the sport. Camp is held at Lloyd Hall on historic Boathouse Row. The camp hours are 9am to 3pm. Campers must bring their own lunch.

Campers must be able to:

Swim and pass a swimming test on the first day of camp.

Be physically fit and able to participate in running and exercise drills.

Participate in other camp activities when not on the river.

Learn to row during one of the Rowing Camp sessions at Lloyd Hall. **Campers may register for one session only.**

Please mark off the session you wish to attend, put the #2 in your second choice, and #3 in your third choice respectively.

Parents please note: If your child has attended this camp in the past, they may not attend again, except if the camper was 13 years old during the 2010 camp. This is to ensure that as many children as possible can have the Rowing Camp experience.

Camp applications are processed in the order that they are received. After an application is received and processed, a letter of acceptance and instructions will be sent to your home along with a request for proof of age and a medical approval form for the camp registrant.

Safety is a top priority — We ensure the safety of every camper with lessons on equipment handling, equipment maintenance and boat/water safety. The staff is comprised of veteran coaches and experienced rowers.
